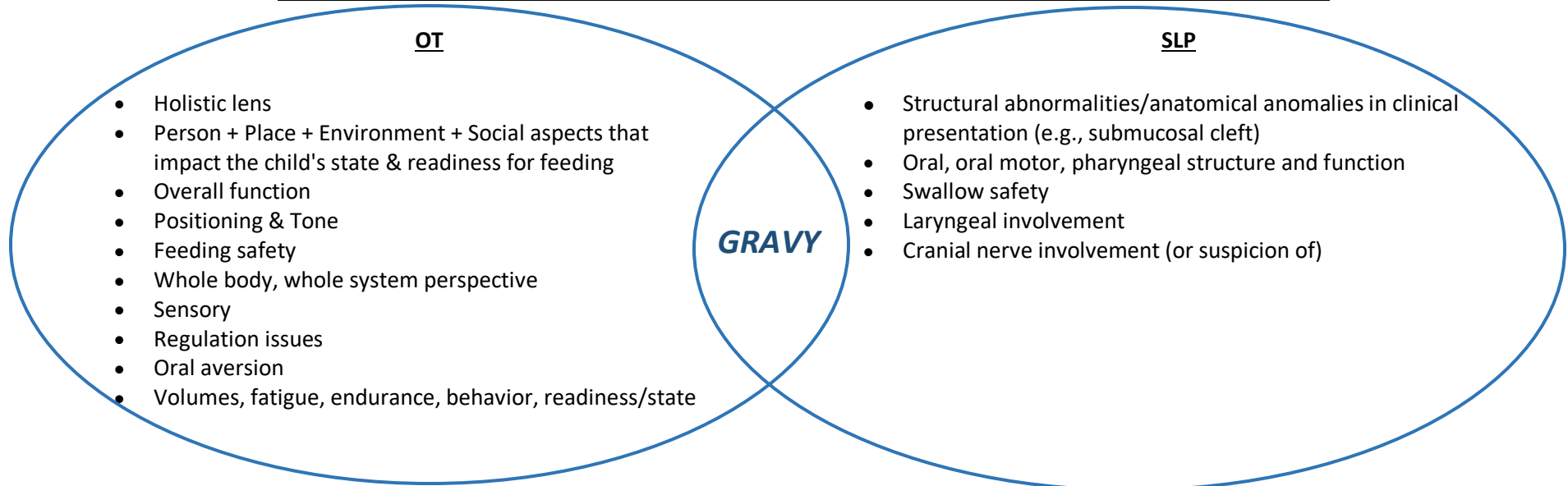


Inpatient Eating, Feeding, Swallowing Care Team

SPECIALTY AREAS IN EATING, FEEDING, SWALLOWING CARE PROVISION:



ACH EFS STATEMENTS/EXPECTATIONS:

- *In collaboration with families, the interdisciplinary teams providing eating, feeding, swallowing care are comprised of OT, RD, SLP and others including lactation consultants, nursing, physicians, psychology, social work. Access to an interdisciplinary team will be available in every situation where EFS concerns are identified, and involvement of team members will be determined collaboratively through an assignment of care process.*
- *ACH practices in an interdisciplinary model where team members collaborate to provide patient- & family-centered, holistic care, focused on a family identified shared goal, with the following areas of specialization acknowledged in the context of feeding disorders:*
 - *RD: nutrition assessment, diagnosis, treatment planning, and intervention to optimize nutrition and growth*
 - *OT: focus on the occupation of eating, feeding & swallowing in the context of person, environment and occupation*
 - *SLP: assessment, diagnosis, and management of the upper aerodigestive system (oral cavity, pharynx, upper esophagus) structure, physiology, and motor and sensory function*
